ANSWER: AMMAN (OR OTHMAR AMMANN)

4. PENCIL AND PAPER READY. FOR 10 POINTS, WHAT IS THE PROBABILITY OF GETTING ONE HEADS AND ONE TAILS ON TWO TOSSES OF A COIN?

7. THE FIRST LINE OF PERCY SHELLEY'S TO A SKYLARK PROVIDED THE INSPIRATION FOR NAME OF THIS WORK, IN WHICH THE DECEASED WIFE, MADAME ARCATI, HAUNTS THE STILL-LIVING HUSBAND. FOR 10 POINTS, NAME THIS MOVIE, STARRING CONSTANCE CUMMINGS AND REX HARRISON, BASED ON A PLAY BY NOEL COWARD.
